The following report updates GAIN <u>IN6119</u> published on September 16, 2016, regarding the Modified Food Import Regulations. The earlier report notes in point (k) information applicable specifically to duty free shops. However, the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has since deleted this clause from its website.

On September 16, 2016, OAA New Delhi published GAIN <u>IN6119</u> regarding the <u>Modified 2016 Food</u> <u>Import Regulations</u>. Point (k) in the report mentioned a clause regarding regulations applicable specifically to duty free shops. FSSAI recently deleted this clause from the document posted on its website. The OAA New Delhi staff also received verbal confirmation to this effect from an FSSAI official during a meeting on September 16, 2016. This updated report is being submitted to reflect this change.
