As previously reported in GAIN report <u>IN6027</u>, India notified its 2016 Food Import Regulations to the World Trade Organization (WTO) and invited comments. The comment period for trading partners, as listed on the WTO website (<u>www.wto.org</u>), expires on April 15, 2016.
